



## CURRENT LOCAL RULES FOR BOTH EAST & WEST COURSES

### PREFERRED LIES ON FAIRWAYS:

"When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: 6 inches from the reference point, **but** with these limits:
- Limits on Location of Relief Area:
  - Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
  - Must be in the general area.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

**Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.**"

### FLAGSTICKS/HOLES:

the ball is considered holed, if **any** part of the ball is below the surface of the putting green **when it comes to rest**, even if not lodged against the flagstick. Please use lifter to retrieve ball and do not use your hand or club head.

**BUNKERS:** "When a player's ball lies in a part of the bunker, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball and playing it from this relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: 6 inches from the reference point, **but** with these limits:
- Limits on Location of Relief Area:
  - the area **cannot** be smoothed before placing.
  - Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
  - Must be in the bunker.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

**Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.**"
